

# Police confirm arrest of suspects who killed, dumped woman in Rivers well

**P**ORT HARCOURT—THE killers of a middle-aged woman, identified as Charity Ohaka, killed and dumped by her assailants in a well have been arrested by operatives of the Rivers State Police Command.

The remains of Charity were discovered and brought out of the well in the compound where she lived at Rumuosi Community in Obio/Akpor Local Government Area on

Sunday, after she had been missing for over four days.

It was learned that the victim, a money lender, was declared missing, as on November 20 unknown persons, who broke into her room and took her away.

Confirming the development in Port Harcourt, the Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Nnamdi Omoni, noted that calm has been restored in the area.

Omoni said: "I can confirm we have been able to identify who her killers are. At the end

of our investigation we will make their identities know to the public."

However, angry youths alleged to be from the community of the victim in Emohua Locla Government Area of the state had invaded Rumuosi with heavy gunfire in reprisal of the killing of their sister.

The invaders destroyed many vehicles and attacked some residents before security operatives brought the situation under control.
