Confirming the incident, the state Public Relations Officer of Federal Road Safety Commission, FRSC, Aques Ogunqbemi, said there was only one casualty in the accident.

She said other victims of the accident have been taken to the hospital.

She said: "I can confirm to you that one person died at the scene of the accident and other victims have been taken to the hospital

"We are on top of the situation trying to move the truck and the other vehicle from the road to ensure traffic flows on the road."
