Again, suspected herdsmen behead farmer, destroy houses in Benue

ARELY one week after suspected herdsmen beheaded two young men in Agatu Local Government Area of Benue State, another person has been beheaded in his farm at Tse Vambe community in Mbawa council

According to a native who did not want his name mentioned, the suspected herdsmen, after beheading the farmer, proceeded to Tse Vambe village and shot sporadically, thereby making residents flee the village.

The source said the sus-

pected herdsmen attacked the community at about 2:30 p.m. on Monday.

He said that the victim was in his farm clearing bush when the herdsmen captured him and later beheaded him before proceeding to the village, where they shot sporadically and set houses on fire. He said: "As I speak to you,

When contacted, the Force Commander of Operation Whirl Stroke, Major-General Adeyemi Yekini, said he was not aware of the current attack but added that his

troops located in Guma were already patrolling the areas.

Efforts to get the confirmation from the police proved abortive as the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Catherine Anene, did not pick calls or respond to text messages sent to her phone.
