

Mob sets 3 criminals ablaze in Yola

YOLA—THREE suspected criminals, who specialized in disposing unsuspecting members of the public off their valuables, have been killed by angry mob in Yola, Adamawa State.

The victims who received jungle justice on Sunday night, were described to as "Shilla boys"

It was gathered that the victims despite the curfew killed and burnt around 10 pm after alleged criminal activities.

According to sources, the victims had earlier disguised as good Samaritans conveying patients from the hospital through a tricycle,

but later dispossessed the passengers off their valuables and speed off.

Following the alarm raised, the fleeing criminals were given a hot chase by passersby and youths of the area.

The sources, said the fleeing criminals were later caught, and burnt after they were clubbed to death.

Following the incident, the Adamawa State Police Command has constituted a Special Task to checkmate the menace of the miscreants.

Announcing this in Yola, yesterday, the Police Image Maker, Suleiman Nguroje, said the task force came because of increasing attacks by miscreants on innocent citizens.
