



Ibadan killings: Local security arrests two suspects

- *One caught trying to kill another woman*
- *Confesses killing 8 victims*

IBADAN—TWO persons suspected to be involved in recent killings in Ibadan have been arrested.

The suspects were said to have been apprehended by local security outfit, Soludero.

The suspects were arrested at different spots in Sasa community of Akinyele Local Government

Area.

One of the suspects, who was arrested yesterday was said to have been caught trying to kill another woman.

When *Vanguard* called the National President of Soludero Hunters Association, Oba Wahab Anabi, he confirmed that it was his people that arrested the suspects at Akinyele area of the state.

He said: "Yes, we have arrested two persons suspected to have killed

innocent people at Akinyele Local Government Area. One was arrested yesterday (Saturday) and another was arrested today (Sunday) while trying to kill another woman.

"The people wanted to roast him alive but the police from Iwo Road rescued him.

"Also, the residents of Sasa community with the help of local security this morning (yesterday)

arrested a suspect in Sasa area of Akinyele Local Government Area while trying to kill another woman.

"While he being interrogated, he allegedly confessed that he had killed eight people recently in Akinyele Local Government Area and that his last killing was at Sasa area where he murdered a lady.

"He has so far been handed over to the Police for further investigation while work is ongoing to fish out other perpetrators."

Contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer of the state command, SP Gbenga Fadeyi, confirmed that two suspects had been arrested by the command.
