

Generator thieves kill night guard in Delta

ASABA — UNIDENTIFIED assailants, weekend, killed a nightguard attached to the Airtel network mast along Agric Road, Asaba, making away with the Jubali power generating plant in the facility.

The incident, which took place Friday night, is coming on the heels of murder of two other night guards in different locations in the state capital where power plants were removed.

It was learned that the hoodlums stormed the site of the mast and inflicted machete injuries on the security guard.

Sources said the deceased was found in the pool of his blood at dawn by neighbours who raised the alarm and called the police to remove the lifeless body.

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer of the State Police Command, Onome Onovwakpoyeya, said the matter was being investigated, reiterating that the long arm of the law would soon catch up with the hoodlums.
