

Owner of sharwama spot, 5 others nabbed over customer's death

OWNER of AVID Sharwama, Mr Chimezie Amaechi, and five other persons have been arrested in connection with the murder of a customer in his shop in Alagbado area of Lagos State.

The deceased, Kayode Olorunroba, 35, who resided at 3, Werewere Street, Alagbado, was shot weekend during an altercation

with another customer at the spot, around 9.30pm.

His friend, Okikiola Kazeem, said to have invited him to the spot, reportedly rushed the dying Olorunroba to a herbalist in Ogun State, where the pellets were extracted.

Thereafter, he took Olorunroba to his brother's house at Ipaja area of Lagos where he died.

Contacted, spokesman for Lagos State Police Command, SP Olumuyiwa Olujobi, said the incident was never reported to the

Police, until the victim died.

He said: "As a follow up to the incident, the Commissioner of Police, Lagos State, CP Hakeem Odumosu, directed that police detectives be mobilised and hunt for the suspects who were linked to the killing. In the course of the investigation, the following persons were arrested: owner of the sharwama spot, Chimezie Amaechi; the deceased's friend, Okikiola Kazeem; Manager of AVID Bar, Olayinka Oyedokun, Femi Victor, Taiwo Morokola, and Omole Wasiu."
