## 10 die in Adamawa auto crash

YOLA— No fewer than 10 persons were feared dead while 40 others were injured in an auto crash involving two trailers conveying cattle from Ganye market in Adamawa State.

The incident occurred Saturday evening along the Ganye-Jada-Mayo Belwa federal highways.

An eyewitness said the two vehicles travelling in the same direction crashed into each other some kilometres to Mayo Belwa in an attempt to overtake at a sharp bend.

Locals confirmed that 10 dead bodies were recovered on the spot as many were taken to the hospital with serious injuries.

They claimed that the accident, which occurred in Jimma village was as a result of overspeeding and reckless driving.

Officials of the Federal Road Safety Commission, FRSC, in Mayo Belwa have confirmed the accident.

The FRSC officials attributed the accident to reckless driving on the part of the two drivers of the ill fated vehicles.

The Information Officer of Mayo Belwa Local Government Area, Alhaji Kabir Kelly, said top officials of the council were at the scene of the accident for possible assistance.
