Sea pirates strike in Rivers, kill father of six

PORT HARCOURT — ONE person has been killed by suspected sea pirates during an attack on a passenger boat in Bille Kingdom, Degema Local Government Area of Rivers State.

The pirates attacked the passenger boat travelling from Bille Kingdom to Port Harcourt on Sunday afternoon.

It was gathered that after the incident, one person, whose name could not be ascertained at press time could not be found in the mangrove, where some of the passengers fled for safe-

The former Community Development Committee, CDC, Chairman of Bille Kingdom, Asatubo Kemuel, who confirmed the development named the murdered victim as Taminoemi Kemuel

He narrated: "On Sunday, the sea pirates making traveling to and fro Bille-Port Harcourt highly miserable for our people attacked a passengers' boat. As a result,

one person is still missing, their valuables and even the speedboat were taken away.

"Sadly, the victim, Mr Taminoemi Kemuel is my first cousin. He was returning to Port Harcourt from Bille Town to when he met his untimely death.

"He is a father of six whose recent children include a set of twins, which births took place a month ago."

He regretted the repeated attacks by pirates on travellers in the area, calling on the government put to end the operations of criminals on the waterways in the area.
