Ojukwu varsity loses 3 students to auto accidents

WKA—THREE female students of the Anambra Stateowned Chukwuemeka Odumegwu Ojukwu University, Igbaniam, reportedly lost their lives in separate road accidents weekend.

The students were said to have died between Friday and Sunday after they boarded motorcycles to their various

destinations.

One of the deceased, a final year student, was said to be rushing for early morning lecture when she lost her life.

Public Relations Officer of the institution, Dr Chukwueloka Christian, who confirmed the incident, described the deaths as unfortunate and blamed it on what he called the recklessness of the motorcyclists.

He, however, regretted that many students have been flouting several warnings against the use of motorcycles

as a means of transportation.

He said that the management might be forced to place a ban on the use of motorcycles by the students to ensure their safety.
