

Gunmen kill Delta anti-cult corps boss

KWALE— KWALE, headquarters of Ndokwa West Local Government Area, Delta State, has been thrown into mourning as the President of the state Anti-Cult Volunteer Corps, AVC, Mr. Austyn Emu was weekend, killed by yet to be identified gunmen.

It was gathered that the anti-cult warlord, a father of three, was driving on Saturday when he was ambushed and killed by suspected cultists.

A security source, who sought anonymity, called on the public not to take laws into their hands, reiterating that the state Police Command would bring those that are connected to Emu's untimely death to book.

He said: "I assure you that even in death, late Austyne deserves justice and those who perpetrated the act must be brought to justice.

"Let us all partner with the police to bring the killers to justice. Those who murdered our friend and working colleague will know no peace until they are arrested, investigated and eventually charged to court."

Contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer of the state command, Onome Onovwakpoyeya, confirmed the killing.

She said someone had invited the deceased, assuring that investigation has commenced into the murder.
