

One hacked to death in Ikorodu suburb

THE Joint Task Force Team (JTF) on security, in conjunction with men of Nigeria Police Force, Ikorodu Division, Lagos State, are currently investigating the murder of one Quadri Okunola, popularly called "Kudeti," by unknown men.

The father of three was hacked to death about 7 pm on Sunday, at Macaulay/Odudu, along Igbogbo/Bayeku Road.

Quadri was said to have left home Sunday morning and returned with a friend in the afternoon before setting out to hang out in a hotel with other friends.

Vanguard gathered that they later left the hotel for another joint. The source said barely had they settled down that the atmosphere changed due to the arrival of some unknown men on motorcycles.

A fight was said to have broken out and Quadri was hacked to death on the spot.

An eye witness said the death of Quadri created tension in the area as the fight extended to Renecon Road.

The eyewitness said the fight might likely be cultist related due to the manner the victim was hacked to death.

Another source said the fight was more of union internal wrangling and supremacy fight as late 'Kudeti' had just been made the Chairman of his unit in Ajah.

The victim's wife popularly called "Mummy Lateef," who was aided to the scene at about 9 pm said she received a distress call from Ajah that her husband had been hacked to death.

When *Vanguard* arrived the scene, the body was soaked in blood, with deep machete cuts on his forehead, skull and throat.

The body was recovered from the scene by policemen from Ikorodu Division, at about 10 pm.
