Suspected ritualist dies inside grave in Enugu

SUKKA—A witch-doctor, who was contracted to unhume the dead body of a weman, collapsed and mon meras the woman's grave.

The witch doctor, Idiko Ezikanyi, from Uwani-Amaoqbo, Amabokwu village in Aku town, Igbo-Etiti Local Government Area of Enuqu State, was allegedly recruited by one Chukwuma Nnadi and other members of his family to secretly dig up the dead body of his wife, late Stella Orlaku Nnadi, who was buried within her husband's compound about five years

Vanauard gathered that on the fateful night, the Nnadi family got more than they pargained for when the witchdoctor they recruited for the ugly job suddenly shouted from the grave, begging the ghost of the dead woman tohave mercy on him.

Sources revealed that Chukwuma, the husband of the late woman, recently yielded to pressure by his family members to secretly

The sources said the family members of the husband nated his late wife with passion and even disinherited their son because the late wife, Oriaku nee Egwete from Ushigo village, was physically challenged.

She suffered a serious infection in intancy, which affected her leg permanently. They didn't want their son to marry her even though the son depended on the lady, who was very industrious despite her deformity to survive.

The sources further alleged that the jealousy and recrimination against her subsequently escalated as it was revealed that the lady stepped on a charm laid for her in her house and after a protracted illness died.

It was gathered that after she died mysteriously, the husband's family refused to pay her full bride price, which

was outstanding before her death and also failed to accord her full burial rites.

Time ticked away and when the family members, who despised her felt that cycrything has quietened, they decided to pack into the house she built. It was discovered that out of a feeling of quilt and fear of spiritual repercussion, they contracted the witch-doctor, who was notorious for attacking graves in the dead of night to exhume her body and throw it into an evil forest.
