Hit and run driver kills motorcyclist in

A commercial motorcyclist was yesterday, killed by a 'hit and run' car driver at Ojuola filling station on Owode-Ijako, Ogun State.

Ogun Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps, TRACE, Owode-Ijako Unit Commander, Mrs Temitope Oseni, said the incident happened at 6.30 a.m.

Oseni said the accident was caused by excessive speeding on the part of the car driver adding that the motorcyclist was riding a Boxer bike with a number plate: MEK 500 WZ.

"The corpse of the victim has been taken away by the family members for burial," she said, adding that the motorcycle had been towed off the road by TRACE operatives to restore the free flow of traffic.

Oseni advised motorists and motorcyclists to drive carefully and exercise patience to avoid loss of lives and property to accidents.
