
MHWUN's scribe, wife, daughter die in auto crash

ADUNA—Secretary-General of Medical and Health Workers Union of Nigeria, MHWUN, Dr Silas Adamu, his wife, Mercy and daughter, Joy, died in an auto crash along Kaduna-Abuja expressway, Monday afternoon.

He was said to have returned to e Abuja, weekend, from Nembe, Bayelsa State for the burial of the e mother of President of MHWUN, Biobelemoye Josiah, and had immediately travelled with his wife and daughter for a family issue only g to die in crash along Abuja-Kaduna highway.

A statement by Jack Lampang, on behalf of MHWUN's President, said: "The Central Working Committee of the Medical and Health Workers Union of Nigeria, MHWUN, wishes to announce the untimely death of its Secretary-General, Dr Silas Adamu, in a ghastly motor accident on the Abuja-Kaduna expressway yesterday (Monday).

"The accident also claimed the lives of his wife, Mercy and daughter, Joy.

In a condolence letter to the union, by the President and acting General Secretary of the National Union of Textile, Garment and Tailoring Workers of Nigeria, NUTGWTN, John Adaji and Ali Baba, respectively, among others, said: "We can imagine the agonising moment the deceased family and your union, in particular, should be passing through with their departure.
