

Siblings fight to death over errand

O SOGBO—OPERATIVES of the Osun State Police Command is on the trail of 21-year-old Toheeb Odetayo, who allegedly killed his younger brother, Lekan Odetayo, 18 during a fight in Modakeke, Osun State.

It was gathered that the siblings argued over an errand, which led to a fisticuff.

A resident of Ifedayo community, Saheed Adeosun, said the brothers were fighting over who will go on an errand.

He said Toheeb later stabbed his younger brother with a knife in the neck region leading to his death before getting to the hospital.

Confirming the incident, yesterday, a police spokesperson in Osun, Yemisi Opalola, said the father, Kazeem Odetayo, reported the incident to the police.

She said Toheeb has been on the run, while the deceased's body was deposited at the Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospital's morgue at Ile-Ife.

"The suspect has been on the run, but the Commissioner of Police, Olawale Olokode has ordered detectives to launch a manhunt for the fleeing suspect," she added.
