Troops kill bandits, demolish camps in Kaduna

TWO bandits were reportedly killed by troops under the auspices of Operation Thunder Strike, OPTS, and One Division, Nigerian Army in the Buruku, Chikun Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

State Kaduna Commissioner, Ministry of Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, this, revealed yesterday, said several other bandits escaped with lifethreatening injuries in an ongoing operation against local five in them government areas of Kaduna Central senatorial district.

He said: "Contact with bandits was made around Buruku village. A firefight ensued, during which two bandits were neutralized. Several bandit camps were also cleared and destroyed during the operation."
