One dies, two injured as truck rams into vehicles in Lagos

TRAGEDY struck in Lagos as an articulated vehicle rammed into a commercial bus and Honda Taxi cab killing one person and leaving two others injured. The incident reportedly occurred at Oshodi, Lagos in the early hours of Friday.

The incident was said to have disrupted free flow of traffic in the axis until rescue operation was completed.

The impact of the accident was said to have led to the death of a yet-to-be identified man on the spot while two others sustained different degrees of injuries.

It was gathered that the truck with number plate KJA 138 XD, suffered brake failure and rammed into a commercial bus with number plate AAA 338 XY and Honda Taxi cab with number plate FKJ 163 AW.

Confirming the incident, LASEMA Spokesperson, Nosa Okunbor said the Agency had to clear the spot and recovered the body to give way to free flow of traffic in the axis.

As at 3.11pm, he said the victim had been bagged and handed over to Police officers from Akinpelu Police Station while the truck and other affected vehicles were recovered from the road with the agency's Super Metro and also handed over to the Police.
