

Widow calls for justice after husband's murder

BENIN—A widow, Mrs Okafor Jane Iyamuka, whose husband was murdered by suspected herdsmen in Benin-City, Edo State, has called on security agencies to fish out those responsible for the death of her husband, just as she expressed worry that her life and that of her child was no longer safe.

The late Mr Philip Okafor was murdered on his way from work in April by suspected herdsmen.

Narrating her plight, Jane said life had been difficult for her and her child since the death of her husband.

She said: "We are no longer safe because till this very moment, nobody has asked us anything, no investigation on my murdered husband's case. This is pathetic for us. We need justice and safety. Our house was also burnt.

"The level of insecurity is getting out of hand daily. I am appealing to all levels of government to come to our aid and ensure there is justice."
