Gunmen kill over 20 in Igangan fresh attack

Six days after the Chairman of Amotekun Corps in Oyo State, Maj. Gen. Ajibola Togun, retd, raised the alarm that some foreign herders were about to unleash terror on the South-West. scores of gunmen, on Saturday night, attacked Igangan in Ibarapa North Local Government Area of the state, folling over 20 persons.

The latest killings, however generated angry reactions from the Alastin of Oyo, Oba Lamidi Adeyemi, who described the attack and killing as devastating dehumanising.

Similarly, the Aarc-Ona-Kakanfo of Yorubaland, Iba Gani Adams, who described the killings as one too many, warned that the attack is an invitation to war
