

3 Police kills 2 suspected robbers in Kogi

THERE was a shoot-out between an armed robbery gang and Police operatives attached to Ajaokuta Area Command of the Kogi State Police Command, Wednesday, at the end of which two suspected members of the gang were gunned down.

The gang said to have been terrorising the state wearing military camouflage were operating at PYN roundabout, Wednesday, dispossessing victims of phones, cash and other valuables.

The operatives were said to have swooped on the gang, killing two of them in a duel that ensued.

The third member was said to have managed to escape with bullet wounds.

A police source in the area commended the state Commissioner of Police, Ede Ayuba, for providing logistics to the operatives, saying "it was a great achievement recorded by police operatives in Ajaokuta area of the state".

He revealed that the stolen items were recovered from the dead suspects, adding that they were still on the manhunt for the fleeing wounded gang.
