2 soldiers, scores of terrorists feared killed in Borno attack

AIDUGURI—At least two soldiers with scores of Boko Haram sect members were feared dead in an early morning affack, yesterday, in Kawuri village, Konduga Local Government Area of Borno state.

Mallam, revealed that the atterrorists went away with Armoured Personnel Carrier, APC, and two operational vehicles belonging to the military and men of the Civilian Joint Task Force, CJTF.

Residents said no civilian casualty was recorded in the attack, as the insurgents did not target the civil populace.

The residents added that none of the corpses of the terrorists was found after the attack, as they quickly evacuated their dead ones in one of their vehicles before fleeing into Sambisa forest.

At press time, there was no official statement from the Deputy Director, Army Public Relations, 7 Div, Col. Ado Isa.
