Kerosene explosions kill 2, injure 4 in Enugu

Nave been confirmed dead, while four others were critically injured when adulterated kerosene exploded in Aku, Igbo-Etiti Local Government Area of Enugu State, yesterday.

An unconfirmed report had it that kerosene vendors adulterated the product with fuel, leading to multiple explosions in various homes of those who bought the product.

Vanguard gathered that one of the victims, Mr John Nnadi of Obie Aku, who lost his life with his mother, Mrs Aneja Nnadi, was a Headmaster in

While confirming the incident, President-

General of Aku General Assembly, AGA, Prof. Godwin Mba, said relevant authorities have been contacted in ensuring that those peddling adulterated kerosene in the community are made to face the full wrath of the law.

The National Public Relations Officer of Aku Welfare Association Federated, AWAF, Ikenna Amadi, also condemned the incident, which he described as "callous and dastardly."

The association urged every resident of the community to stop the use of kerosene till further notice.
