Suspect in Police cell for allegedly slapping tricycle rider to death in llorin

LORIN—ONE Kayode Oluwatomi has been arrested by police operatives in Kwara State for illegedly killing a tricycle rider, who nit his car in Ilorin, the state capital, Monday.

An eyewitness said the suspect, Kayode Oluwatomi, was driving a plack Honda car with number plate 3X 954 AJL around the Egbejila area of Ilorin when he was reportedly hit rom behind by a tricycle operator, one Kola Adeyemi.

The eyewitness added that one of he parking lights of the car was lamaged, which infuriated the suspect.

"The tricycle operator, who admitted juilt, pleaded with the driver to collect V2000 for the replacement of the proken parking light valued at N2,500.

"The Honda car driver bluntly efused the offer and arguments ensued among the tricycle operator and other onlookers who intervened in the matter.

"Consequently the Honda cardriver jot angry and slapped the tricycle operator, who slumped immediately.

The eyewitness said the victim was aken to the nearby Garin Alimi nospital where he was confirmed dead.

Other tricycle riders promptly eported the incident at Budo Nuhu police station and the suspect, the Honda cardriver, was arrested.

The Spokesman of Kwara State Police command, Kayode Okasanmi, who confirmed the incident, said, "I'm I ware of the incident, the Honda car I liver has been arrested and he's currently undergoing interrogation. As soon as the investigation is completed he will be charged to court."
