

Missing man found dead inside car in Abeokuta

ABEOKUTA—A man simply identified as Isiaka, declared missing by his family members three days ago, was found dead inside his car around Olomore area of Abeokuta, the Ogun State capital.

The family had reported at Adigbe divisional police headquarters that the deceased left home in his car, but never returned.

A source told our correspondent that the search for the man yielded no result until Tuesday when he was found dead in his car along Olomore area of the State capital.

The body has since been evacuated by the police.

When contacted, Ogun State Police Public Relations Officer, Abimbola Oyeyemi, confirmed the incident.

Oyeyemi said the family had requested that the body be released for burial according to Islamic rites, adding that the cause of his death was still being investigated.

"The man was reported missing about three days ago at Adigbe police station, and a case of a missing person was reported, only for us to get information today (Wednesday) that the man's dead body was discovered inside his vehicle. We are investigating the cause of his death.

"The family has demanded the corpse be released because they want to bury him according to Islamic rites," the PPRO said.
