
An eye witness said the driver of the Hisce bos rammed into a stationary trailer which had a tyre burst while counting money on steering.

The state Sector Commander of the Federal Road Salety Corps, FRSC, Mr Adeoye Ireleways, attributed the total crash to excessive speed.

He said: "The crash involved two vehicles, a Mercedes Teiler with number plates: XF-123-JJT commercial and a Toyota Flace bus commercial, with number plates: XC-505ATN belonging to Imo State Transport Company (KTC).

"Nine people." Smale adults were and 4 female adults were involved in the crash. Six canalties, three male adults and three female adults, sustained varying degrees of injury, while two make adults were folled.
