

Man kills cousin over argument in Ogoni

PORT HARCOURT— POLICE in Rivers state are on the trail of a man identified as Bobby Gabriel, now on the run after allegedly stabbing his cousin, Kopapa Neete to death in Duburo community in Khana Local Government Area, Rivers State.

Vincent Gbosi, Chairman, Duburo Community Development Committee, who confirmed the incident yesterday, said Gabriel in his early twenties stabbed Neete in his early forties to death Sunday night over an argument.

"Bobby Gabriel stabbed Kopapa Neete to death. They're cousins. As a community, we complained to the Bori Divisional Police Office.

"We call on the government to look into the state of insecurity in the community. The suspected killer fled the community after killing the cousin. He has not been seen since then," the CDC Chairman stated.

The Rivers State Police Command was yet to state the incident at the time of filing this report.
