

2 dead, one rescued as trucks collide on Lagos/Ibadan Expressway

TWO persons were feraed dead while another was rescued, yesterday, in an accident involving two trucks in the Ogun State axis of Lagos/Ibadan expressway.

The incident reportedly occurred at Ienuwa, about 10.25a.m., inbound Lagos.

Vehicles involved were a Hanvan lowberg truck with numberplate, WDE 79 XB, and another truck laden with granite.

According to eyewitnesses, both trucks were inbound Lagos when the event occurred.

It was learned that the Hanvan

lowberg truck was trying to make a detour, while the granite-laden truck travelling from behind lost control and rammed into it on the driver's side due to break failure.

The impact of the accident was said to have affected both truck drivers, who reportedly died on the spot.

However, the motor boy of the granite-laden truck was said to have survived the crash.

Vanguard gathered that the bodies
