

Man kills wife over argument in Nasarawa

It was a moment of grief in Sabon Pegi—Shubu, Lafia North Development Area, Nasarawa State, on Friday, when a mother of three children was allegedly beaten to death over an argument that ensued between her and her husband.

It was gathered that the

argument started when Mrs Esther Aya engaged a carpenter to fix window net in their family house, when the husband ordered the carpenter to stop the work, an action that angered the wife.

An eye witness, who claimed to be the carpenter, alleged that Esther's husband chased him away when he was trying to fix the win-

dow net.

The wife, a teacher with Government Secondary School, Doka, had been embroiled in crisis with her husband over the ownership of the house both lived in which snowballed into lawsuit.

The police confirmed the arrest of Yakubu, the husband.
