

22-year-old lady found dead behind mum's shop in Osun

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OSOGBO—There was palpable tension at Oke-Oore area of Iwo, as a 22-year-old girl simply identified as Shakirah, was found dead in the area with some parts of her body missing.

It was gathered that her body was dumped by suspected ritualists at the back of her mother's shop at Oke-Oore, in the town.

Findings showed that Shakirah left home on Wednesday morning and did not return and her corpse was discovered behind her mother's shop yesterday.

An eyewitness at the place where her body was found, Usman Akeem, disclosed that some vital parts of the lady were removed by her killers.

According to him, it was suspected that the lady was dumped by yahoo boys, who might have used her for money ritual.

"She left home Wednesday and did not return at night. Her corpse was found behind her mother's shop today (Thursday). We noticed that some vital parts have been removed before they dumped her behind her mother's shop.

"The police came and took her remains to their station. We later learnt that they took her to the morgue at Iwo General Hospital," he added.

Osun police command spokesperson, Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the incident.
