

② Ahmed Gulak: Imo Police arrest suspected killer

OWERRI— THE Imo State Police Command, yesterday, paraded a suspect, Chimobi Anosike, 38 years old man from Umuedo, Obioha in Ahiazu Mbaise Local Government Area, for alleged involvement in the killing of the former aide to ex-President Goodluck Jonathan, Ahmed Gulak, on May 30, 2021, while he was travelling back to Abuja, along Imo Airport Road in Ngor Okpala Local Government Area of Imo State.

The Imo State Police Public Relations Officer, Michael Abattam, during the parade said the suspect was arrested by the anti-kidnapping unit of the command following an intelligence report.

He said: "The gang was also responsible for razing of some police divisions in the state including the Aboh, Ahiazu Mbaise and Ezinihite police stations. The suspect, who is a member of the Indigenous People of Biafra, IPOB, has confessed also to be among the gang that attacked a truck loaded with onions the same day at Enyiogwugwu junction, Aboh Mbaise and also involved in the killing of some police officers in the state."

The suspect told newsmen that he was misled by the gang commander, "Virus," now at large, who also threatened to kill him if he pulls out.

He said: "I was a commercial bus driver when our commander saw me and asked me to drive them somewhere on that day. I never knew where we were going to. I didn't want to say no because he said he was going to kill me."

The suspect added that when they got to the airport road, "he asked me to block the vehicle in front, I did and one of them shot him, he did not die. So, Johnny came and removed something from his body and shot him before he died. I didn't know he was the one."
