Mr Ahmed Umar, the Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Ogun, who confirmed this to newsmen in Abeokuta, yesterday, said: "The accident occurred this morning (Tuesday) at about 6:25 a.m. Involved a Mazda bus with number plate YYY 412 XB and an unregistered truck.

"The Mazda bus driver, who was at high speed, crashed into the moving truck from behind due to a slight detect on the truck.
