3 killed as bandits attack Taraba community

JALINGO—No fewer than three persons were reportedly killed, Sunday, by bandits in Bali town, Taraba State.

The assailants, according to reports, came on motorcycles to unleash mayhem on the community and also whisked away some persons.

The Chief of Tiv in Bali, Zaki David Gbaa, said two of his subjects were among the deceased, adding that some persons, including women, were taken away by the bandits.

Acting Chairman of Bali LGA, Ahmed Isa, who spoke to Vanguard via telephone, confirmed the attack, saying he was waiting to be briefed by the police before speaking to the press.

Contacted, spokesman of the state police command, DSP Abdullahi Usman, also confirmed the casualty figure.
