## Fresh graduate, 2 others killed as robbers attack banks in Kogi

OKOJA—A young lady, who just graduated, was among three persons reportedly killed by gunmen that attacked commercial banks in Ankpa, headquarters of Ankpa council area of Koqi State, Tuesday night.

Vanguard gathered that the robbers arrived in the town in three vehicles and some on motorbikes through the eastern flank, blocked all exit routes and operated uninterrupted for about three hours.

An eyewitness said the robbers attacked the police station in the town before making their way to First and Zenith banks with heavy gunshots.

"After robbing the banks for about an hour, they drove violently through the town shooting sporadically. They left Ankpa through Okpo Olamaboro Local Government Area road, but no one knew their destination as the shots were too heavy for the police to curtail."

One of the victims was reportedly hit by a stray bullet, making residents to scamper for safety.

However, the Police through the state Public Relations Officer, SP. William Anya, said it was able to engage the robbers in gun battle as most of the robbers ran away with bullet wounds.

"Consequent upon the robbery attack on UBA, FirstBank and Zenith Bank, Ankpa simultaneously, the police personnel on duty both at the

station and the banks quickly recovered from the sudden attack and gallantly repelled the attackers, who were forced to flee, some into nearby bushes, others with their vehicles. The hoodlums abandoned three vehicles used for the operation in their haste to escape.


