"We enjoin the general public to be peaceful and law abiding as we call on the police to fish out the perpetrators and bring them to face the full wrath of the law.

"The kingdom will con-

tinue to collaborate with security agencies in order to forestall further reoccurrence and curb the growing challenge of kidnapping in the area.

"We should learn to report or handover to the police if any person is caught with guns or other dangerous weapons within Mosogar Kingdom.

"Finally, we implore everyone to go about their normal businesses as the security agencies are on top of the situation"
