

Suspected herders kill one, injure others in Edo community

BENIN CITY— SUSPECTED kidnappers believed to be criminal Fulani herdsman have again invaded Sobe community in Owan West Local Government Area of Edo State, killing one Ome Osesa said to be a driver and injuring others.

This is came two weeks after suspected kidnappers abducted one in the same community and injured another.

A source in the community, who preferred anonymity,

said the herdsman invaded the deceased's house in the evening and opened fire on him and anyone on sight.

He said: "The herdsman invaded the community, killing Osesa in his house and injuring many others. They later left Omesa's residence and moved to St Thomas Moore Primary School, where they also kidnapped some persons.

"The rate of killing by the Fulani herdsman in Sobe community in Owan West has become too many."
