

Suspected cultists stab Ondo varsity student to death

AKURE —A yet-to-be identified student of the Ondo State-owned Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko, has reportedly stabbed to death by suspected cultists.

A source alleged that an argument over N1,000 between the student and an indigene of the community caused the crisis.


Consequently, friends of the deceased protested and mobilised to the house of the mother of one of the suspected killers in the community and set it ablaze.

Vanguard gathered that the incident happened off-campus.

It was further learned that following the death of the student, others took to the streets to protest the incident.

The timely intervention of police detectives and security guards attached to the school averted bloodbath between the students and the indigenes of the community.

image maker, Funmi Odunlami confirmed the incident, saying the student was confirmed dead at the hospital where he was rushed to.

Odunlami said: "An indigene had an issue with a student and one thing led to the other

and he stabbed the student, which resulted to the student's death.

"Students took to the street to protest, but as the corpse was being taken to the morgue by police, some people mobilised to the suspect's mother's house and set it ablaze."
