

Nursing graduate found dead after nightclub outing in Ibadan

Tragedy struck in Ibadan yesterday, as a young nurse, Omoniyi Boluwatife, was gruesomely killed by yet to be-identified assailants.

The incident, according to Saturday Vanguard, happened two days after her induction into the Nursing and Midwifery Council of Nigeria, adding a chilling layer to the already gripping tale.

As gathered, Boluwatife, a graduate from Lead City University, made her way to a night club in Ibadan to mark the celebration of her recent induction.

A concerned woman in the university community was seen lamenting over the

cruel murder of the lady.

She said: "We told them to be careful where they would go last night. It is very unfortunate that she has ended her life like that. However, her joyful occasion swiftly transformed into a tragic ordeal as she was sadly discovered dead the following morning".

Prior to her ill-fated night out, Boluwatife, as gathered, had bid farewell to her mother, who had travelled from Port Harcourt, Rivers State to join in her celebration.
