

Woman, 2 others feared killed as herdsman attack Enugu community

① **SUSPECTED HERDSMEN** have killed three people, including a woman in an attack on Opi Agu in Nsukka Local Government of Enugu.

② This came barely two days after another three in Agbada Nenwe community were killed by masked gunmen, who invaded the community.

It was gathered the assailants in Nsukka launched the attack Monday at Enya Uhuchiri village.

Village sources said the herders had arrived at about 4 pm on Monday with their cattle on the farms of the villagers.

One of them said: "We are now living in fear. I just confirmed the death of our brother who they killed yesterday night at Enya Uhuchiri.

"I also learned about the

deaths of two others, including a woman. This is so sad.

"It happened that when they came with their cattle, the cattle started eating and destroying crops and vegetables planted by the farmers, some of whom were still in their farms. They (farmers)

reacted and chased the herders with their cattle away and warned them never to return to the farms anymore.

"They ran away with their cattle and nobody suspected anything until in the dead of the night when they invaded

people's houses and inflicted deaths and deep cuts on them".

Spokesman of the police command, Daniel Ndukwe, said he is yet to be briefed on the incident and promised to react as soon as he has the information.

Sponsors of insurgents in Nigeria live abroad —Anambra CP

AWKA—THE Anambra State Commissioner of Police, Aderemi Adeoye has said that those who sponsor insurgency in the South East live abroad, explaining that they are mostly indigenes of the states in the

geo-political zone.

Adeoye, who spoke with reporters in Awka, lamented that those they sponsor give them the false impression that they are making progress when, in fact, they are merely ripping them off.

Adeoye said: "Most of them (sponsors) are abroad, but they

are indigenes, who are misled and misguided about the true nature of the conflict.

"Their main source of information is the propaganda they read on social media and they continue to give them false perception that the realization of the Republic of Biafra is imminent, and all they need to do is to sustain the onslaught.

"And their onslaught comprises of firing three rounds at a military
