

Bandits kill 2 drivers, injure another in Kaduna community

Kaduna—Bandits have killed two commercial drivers and injured another, along a highway in Birnin Gwari Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

The drivers were identified as Mustapha Adamu, and Malam Mukhtar, whom the villagers said was popularly known as ‘Teacher’.

The Police Public Relations Officer in Kaduna State, Mansir Hassan was yet to react to the incident as at time of this report.

However, a relation of the drivers, Malam Shehu told journalists that the drivers were returning to Birnin Gwari around 3:30pm on Saturday when the bandits shot their vehicles.

He said another driver lost his eyes when he was hit by a bullet, and was taken to a medical facility for treatment.

Shehu said the bandits had earlier killed a local hunter, Bashir of Unguwar Shekarau in Birnin Gwari Local Government Area.

“The local hunter was shot while they were retreating the highway. The bandits

“The local hunter was shot while they were patrolling the highway. The bandits attacked the hunters on Wednesday. That was before the Saturday attack that claimed the lives of the 2 commercial drivers along the highway.”

“Those that were injured including the driver who lost his eye are receiving treatment in the hospital,” he said
