Farmers/herders clash claims one life in Kebbi

FARMERS and herders clash, on Wednesday, claimed one life and one other injured, in the Rango Asarara in Birnin Kebbi Local Government Area of Kebbi State.

A local from Ambursa town, a stretch to Asarara village, who

craved to be unknown for security reasons said that persons alleged to be Fulani herders were seen in the farms eating up crops belonging to the Hausas in the village and were asked to remove their cows from the farm but their resistance led to fight, which claimed the life of one person and another injured.

The source added that

Ambursa town has been codoned off by armed police as security presence in Ambursa town and Asarara village has increased to contain the situation from reaching bioling point, while Ambursa town is under luck and key as there is no entry and exit of persons or goods.

The Ambursa resident said

that lots of Fulanis from the village where the incident happened have been taken hostage in connection with the alleged killing of the farmer.

Kebbi State Command imagemaker, Nafiu Abubakar said on phone that he would make enquiries on the incident and get back to our correspondent.
