

# Man, 70, daughter, 50, beheaded in Delta land dispute

A 70-year-old man, Mr. Aghanti and his 50-year-old daughter, Mrs Atagoshi, have been reportedly beheaded in a bush at Amai community, Ukwuani Local Government Area, Delta State over a suspected land dispute.

The headless bodies of the father and daughter were said to have been found after they

were called by the suspect, to come with him into the bush.

Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Mr. Bright Edafe, confirmed the killings yesterday.

It was learnt that the woman, a secondary school teacher, had bought a piece of land in the community with some persons allegedly claiming ownership of it later.

Edafe said the assailant had called the woman that he wanted to have a discussion with her about the land.

He now took them to Amai community bush, killed them and cut off their heads.

On that same day (Friday), the vigilante caught one Emeke with two human heads, so he was mobbed and burnt to death. When the people checked, they discovered that the human heads were those of the father and the daughter.

They originally saw the body of the father and the daughter without heads, the police spokesperson stated.
