

Ondo health worker killed by suspected kidnappers

A 46 year old health worker in Ondo state, Akinola Oyabiyi, has been murdered by suspected kidnappers in Eleyowo community, in Akure North local government area of the state.

Sources said that the deceased was returning from office in his vehicle when he was attacked and shot dead at about 8pm by the killers.

Saturday Vanguard learnt that the abductors shot him at close range while he tried to escape from the kidnappers who stopped him on the highway.

They were said to have fled the scene leaving the deceased to bleed to death. Sources said that when help finally came, and he was reportedly rushed to the hospital, doctors declared him dead on arrival at the hospital, having lost so much blood.

Recall that some farmers were equally killed in the same community two weeks ago.

Also, three interns of the Federal School of Agriculture in Akure, were abducted in the same area last week Saturday.

Contacted, the spokesperson for the state police command, Funmi Odunlami confirmed the incident and promised that police detectives would soon fish out the perpetrators.
