

Many feared dead in Nyanya-Mararaba auto crash

ABUJA—Some persons were, yesterday, feared dead after an accident, the second in 24 hours, occurred around the Karu bridge on the Nyanya-Mararaba road in Abuja, the nation's capital.

Vanguard gathered that an accident had occurred on Sunday evening involving seven vehicles.
