Meanwhile, two lives were lost in the auto crash while nine others were injured. Eyewitness account said that the accident involved a Toyota Sienna bus traveling to Abuja. The commercial bus reportedly somersaulted after it had a burst tyre. Speaking on the crash, the Ondo Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Samuel Ibitoye who

confirmed the crash, said that the corpses of the victims have been deposited at the morgue. Ibitoye, said that those injured in the crash were rushed to the Okeagbe Akoko General Hospital for treatment."

He urged drivers to exercise caution on the highways, emphasizing the importance of vehicle maintenance and safe driving practices to prevent such accidents.

According to him "This incident highlights the need for regular vehicle checks and adherence to traffic rules to ensure safety on Nigerian roads.

He said that "The Federal Road Safety Corps has consistently emphasized the importance of responsible driving and proper vehicle maintenance in preventing accidents.
