Tragedy struck early today in Osogbo, the Osun State capital when pandemonium broke out between two rival gangs which led to the death of Biola, an aide to Mr. Sunday Igboho, a popular politician and socialite.

The deceased was killed opposite Zenith Bank Oke-Fia hours after the two gang clashed at the popular Riverside Lounge in Oke-fia area of Osogbo.

Report from a reliable source said the fight was as a result of leadership tussle between one Dlaw and Asiri Eniba, both who are reportedly loyal to the ruling party, the All Progressives Congress.
