10 Dead In Lagos Accident

10 people on Thursday morning were burnt to death as a fuel tanker went up in flames around Alakija, on the Badagry Expressway in Lagos State.

About 10 vehicles were completely burnt in the accident and several occupants of the affected vehicles escaped injured.

The fire incident created panic among residents of the communities along the expressway, especially among relations of people who had gone to work before the incident, while the burnt tanker caused serious traffic on the expressway.

The explosion occurred a day after over 10 people were burnt to death as a passenger bus exploded around Magodo on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

The tanker was said to be laden with content suspected to be Premium Motor Spirit (PMS).

The Lagos Police Command says, the incident is already being investigated.
