Truck rams into 15 vehicles, kills one in Abuja

TRAGEDY truck in Abuja on Wednesday when a truck con-

veying bags of cement had a brake failure and rammed into 15 other vehicles at Power House Junction in Asokoro District.

The accident left one person dead and several others injured, as policemen and Vehicle Inspection Officers (VIOs) made frantic efforts to clear the road to ease traffic

congestion on the Abuja-Keffi

Road.

Narrating the incident, one of the victims, Wan Avuba, told Daily Independent that driver of the said truck lost control, as his conductor was screaming and waving at other road users to stay clear of the road.

Ayuba, a staff of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC), noted that his own vehicle was smashed by the truck as well

as several others. Divisional Police Officer (DPO) in charge of Asokoro Police Station, Ahmed Musa,

confirmed one person dead

and that four others who were in critical condition have been rushed to Asokoro General Hospital. He said driver of the illfated truck has been arrested and kept in police custody, adding that investigation would be thoroughly carried out. Some people who spoke to Daily Independent at the

scene of the accident appealed to the Federal Government to restrict movement of trucks and tankers on the road, particularly at peak hours to reduce incessant carnage involving them.

It would be recalled that a similar accident occurred

about a week ago on the same road, when a truck had a brake failure and crushed three other vehicles, leaving

in its wake seven people dead and several others injured. Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Central Business Area, Frank Agbakoba,

expressed regrets on the fre-

quent road traffic accidents,

adding that the matter would be investigated and necessary action taken to mitigate it.
